Confessions for Identity & Purpose

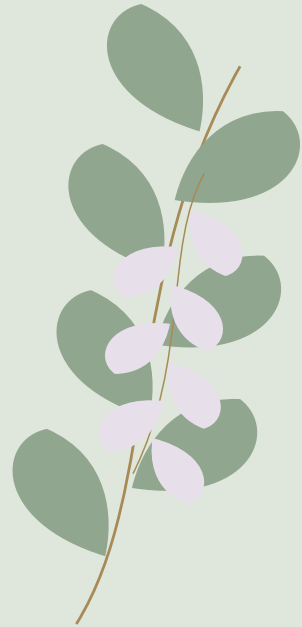
Chosen. Loved. Created with purpose.
Agree with who God says you are.

ANCHORED IN SCRIPTURE

“For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above-spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].”

A faith-filled invitation to live from your identity in Christ.



Know who you are

Your worth begins with God, not the opinions of others.

Read the Scripture in context. Speak each confession slowly.

Ask God to show you one way to live it today.

CREATED WITH PURPOSE

God's Word says I am His workmanship. Therefore, I confess that my life carries God-given purpose, and I will not measure my worth by another person's path.

Ephesians 2:10 AMP

02

CHOSEN AND LOVED

I am chosen and deeply loved by God. Rejection does not have the final word over my identity.

Colossians 3:12 AMP

03

BELONGING THROUGH GRACE

I belong to God. I do not have to perform for a place that His grace has already given me.

1 Peter 2:9 AMP

04

MADE NEW IN CHRIST

My present circumstances do not have the authority to rename me. I receive the identity God gives me in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:17 AMP

05

RELEASE COMPARISON

I will not allow comparison to make me despise the grace, pace, or gifts God has entrusted to me.

Galatians 6:4-5 AMP

Grow in grace

You can grow without denying who God says you are.

Pause. Speak with intention. Put the Word into practice.

GRACE FOR YOUR GROWTH

Because God is at work within me, I can grow without condemning myself for being unfinished.

Philippians 1:6 AMP

07

STRENGTH IN WEAKNESS

I am not disqualified by weakness. Christ's grace meets me there and teaches me to depend on His strength.

2 Corinthians 12:9 AMP

08

STEWARD YOUR GIFTS

God has given me gifts to steward in love. I will use them faithfully rather than bury them in fear.

1 Peter 4:10 AMP

09

WALK WITH COURAGE

I choose courage over self-erasure. I can take the next faithful step without needing everyone's approval.

Galatians 1:10 AMP

10

RENEW YOUR MIND

My mind can be renewed. Old labels and limiting beliefs do not have to govern my future choices.

Romans 12:2 AMP

Walk in your purpose

Let your identity in Christ shape your everyday choices.

Pause. Speak with intention. Put the Word into practice.

ROOTED IN CHRIST

I am rooted in Christ. My confidence grows from who He is, not from applause, titles, or visible results.

HONOR HIS DESIGN

I can honor the way God formed me while remaining humble, teachable, and willing to grow.

ASK FOR WISDOM

I have access to God's wisdom. I do not have to force clarity or pretend to know what I do not know.

James 1:5 AMP

PRACTICE YOUR PURPOSE

I will walk in love, integrity, and obedience. Purpose is practiced through faithful choices, not merely admired as an idea.

Ephesians 5:1-2 AMP

15

AGREE WITH HIS WORD

God's Word is the truest voice over my life. I choose to agree with His character, His grace, and His transforming work within me.

John 8:31-32 AMP

Rooted. Renewed. Ready.

Let these words take root in your everyday life.

01 / RELEASE THE LABELS. RECEIVE THE TRUTH.

Which labels have shaped the way you see yourself? Which agree with God's Word, and which need to be released? Write one truth you want to practice believing this week.

02 / SPEAK THIS ALOUD

Read the closing confession slowly three times. Pause after each sentence. Which words are hardest to receive? Write one way you will put this truth into practice.

MY CLOSING CONFESSION

I am God's workmanship, held by His grace and invited into faithful purpose. I release comparison, limiting labels, and the pressure to prove my worth. My identity is rooted in Christ, and I will steward what God has placed within me one obedient step at a time.
